

Would you recommend the T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood® lowa program to other people working with young children?




"It really helps to lessen the burden of college costs, and allows you to go at your own pace to earn a degree. The extra paid time off work and bonus at the beginning really helped me out."


"I think it's a great opportunity to help those who need it. Working with children is not as easy as people may think but TEACH makes it rewarding."

After attending college classes, T.E.A.C.H. recipients perceive their skills as a teacher to be:




"I have been able better assess my students to provide developmentally appropriate activities and helped me create more productive lesson plans to meet their needs."

"I have new techniques to handle behaviors"


"Teaching students in a way that meets learning objectives instead of just planning activities for busy work."
